## **Wiz-Tec announces deal to provide retail lanes and support for new NSIFTE Gas Bar for use with the NSIFTE (Nova Scotia Indian Fuel Tax Exemption) Program.**

Calgary, Alberta, January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2006 – Wiz-Tec Computing Technologies Inc. announced today that the NSIFTE program wants a First Nation member in Nova Scotia to participate in the program. Once again, the Nova Scotia government has chosen Wiz-Tec's VisualPOS 3.3 Point of Sale software solution for its Gas bar site in Annapolis Valley. This brings the total number of participating Reserve gas bars to 17.

Wiz-Tec expects to focus more of its business efforts on Indian tax exemption programs in future, and First Nations members are exciting additions in Wiz-Tec's efforts to build out the software services they offer. There is a high degree of interest in Wiz-Tec, and the response from the First Nations communities has been very positive.
